IECs are not agents - they do not represent any college and do not get a commission for placing students.

Independent of influence, they represent the student's interests.



IECs are not a replacement for school counsellors!

- IECs CAN support school counsellors in strategically **managing** the application process to ensure deadlines are met, keeping effective communication between all stakeholders.
- They can reinforce the inputs the other offers to the students.
- The aim is to employ a **collaborative approach** which helps both the parties **serve the student** effectively.





Independent Education Consultants

What an IEC can do

- Developing the **narrative for** the application
- Give one on one focussed attention
- Tailored advice for students applying for any programs, especially creative **programs**: Film, fashion, design, music, and student-athletes
- Specialist support for students with **learning challenges**
- Knowledge of **unusual programmes** of study, such as accelerated medical entry



Independent Education Consultants

What an IEC cannot do

- Writing the counsellor's letter of Recommendation
- Gather teacher's letter of recommendation
- **Providing exact data** on the **school's admissions trends**including who applied where, how was their profile, etc.
- Know who the students are up against, from within their own schools
