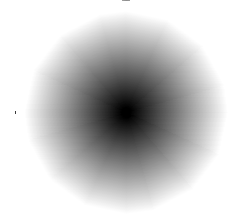
WHAT CAN STUDENTS/FAMILIES/COUNSELORS EXPECT?

- Increased support from post-secondary schools in Canada regarding the visa process

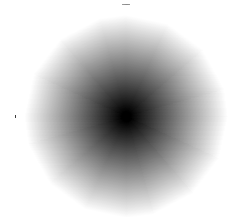

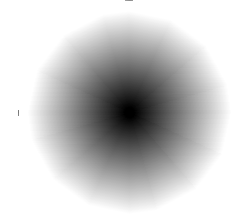
