#### **Government Scholarship Programs** and THE LIST

Bahrain, Egypt, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, and UAE currently fund government scholarship programs. These governments maintain lists of approved receiving institutions, which can often be the chief barrier to recruiting funded students from these countries.
