As politically nationalist winds continue to blow globally and technology reshapes our world at a blistering pace, there are many challenges facing the international education industry. With governmental policies impacting visa and immigration, access to finance, and economic trends our various contexts continue to experience shifting sands. These pressures increase the uncertainty in both short and long-term planning for families and institutions alike. Our ability as an organization to raise awareness and present solution-focused advocacy for these issues will be vital.

We've already begun to see the impact of these issues in our school communities globally as international student populations shift, international educators move at a rapid pace, and competition for students in various regions heats up. This pressure often emerges in the form of a shift in how we measure and celebrate student success. In other words, the emphasis on successful student outcomes changes from a "best fit" lense to an assessment of destinations against a subjective ranking list.

In the years and months ahead our industry will continue to face challenges, it is our duty as an organization to mitigate impact and remain steadfast in our efforts to champion our mission "To facilitate global interaction among counselors and institutions in support of secondary students transitioning to higher education, while promoting professional standards that foster ethical and social responsibility." Regardless of our professional role within the industry, we all have a role to play to ensure that students come first, by engaging with students and elevating their voices to advocate and champion what is best for the young people in our car. We must continue to ask difficult questions, have difficult conversations, innovate, increase access, drive change and be kind.

The three pillars of the strategic plan have guided the Communications Committee's work since before my tenure began in August of 2024. During this time we've worked to:

- Increase engagement and connectedness globally. This has led to the recent (re-)launch of our Regional Counselor Resources in the Member Info Hub which strengthens our goal of broader regional representation and connection.
- Maintain current communication channels through regular moderation and management and lay the groundwork to develop additional avenues for engagement.
- Increase our presence on socials to encourage members to better leverage member resources such as the jobs board, webinars, and volunteer opportunities.
- Contributed to the exploration and development of regional partnerships.
- Optimized our internal committee operations by developing an onboarding program, establishing subcommittees, and organizing our internal resources and historical documents.
- Collaborated with other members of the board to develop guidelines on Public Statements and among the Communications Committee to revise our social media policy to provide clarity for current and future organizational volunteers tasked with navigating challenging global events.

To summarize, our efforts have enhanced the member experience globally, clarified the international brand, and optimized internal operations. Should I be given the opportunity to continue as VP of Communications, I'll align our initiatives with the outcome of the proposed Board Restructure and work to drive the organization forward over the next term.
